# "BUSINESS SUCCESS THROUGH INTEGRITY IN THE SUPPLY CHAIN" With the enforcement of Section 17 A of MACC Act in 2020, it is essential to enhance collective initiatives in the private sector against corruption in Malaysia in order to mitigate corporate risks under the amended Act. Coalition for Business Integrity Bhd. (CBI), a non-profit apolitical business integrity association, is organising a half-day conference in Penang on July 4th, jointly with UN Global Compact Network Malaysia & Brunei (UNSCMY8) and MICCI (Malaysian International Chamber of Commerce & Industry) with the theme "Business Success through Integrity in the Supply Chain". The objective of the conference is to showcase business success in the value added chain and to develop collective initiatives to promote business integrity and transparency in Malaysia.
